Here is a sample letter to the applicants pastor::

This member from your congregation has applied to attend an upcoming Via de Cristo weekend. These weekends are designed to provide faith renewal for Christians by grounding them more fully in God's grace and in the disciplines of prayer, study and service. The purpose of the weekend is for participants to return to their home congregations renewed and better equipped to serve their church as leaders. Like Marriage Encounter, which seeks to strengthen healthy marriages rather than heal troubled ones, Via de Cristo is designed to strengthen faith rather than provide spiritual conversion for a non-believer.

In addition, it is our hope that married persons will be able to attend consecutive weekends so that they can share the experience together. This can be a very positive thing. If one partner is unable to do this, but could at a later date, we encourage the couple to wait. If one partner simply does not want to attend a weekend and is unlikely to ever do so in the future, then we wish to know whether or not you as their pastor have any concerns on the impact of the weekend on their marriage.

If you do not have any concerns about your parishioner's involvement in this weekend, we ask for your signature of support. If you have any apprehension, we would appreciate hearing from you. If you wish to talk to one of our spiritual directors about Via de Cristo, please call Rev. Anne Strickert at (309) 394-2208.

Sponsor's Responsibilities

"It is not enough to make a good selection of applicants, but this brings with it the need for giving them proper individual and very special care..." before, during and after their Via de Cristo.

Everyone must recognize that they assume certain responsibilities when they sponsor someone. Some of those responsibilities are:

1. The sponsor shall prayerfully consider all factors in determining whom to sponsor. Any special needs should be communicated to the Pre-Weekend Chair in writing at the time the application is submitted so that appropriate plans can be made.
2. It is the sponsor's responsibility to see that the application is received by the Pre-Weekend Chair at least five weeks prior to the weekend date.
3. The applicant should be contacted and his or her intentions to attend confirmed no later than 2 weeks prior to the weekend.
4. Prayers should be made for the spiritual growth of the applicant and for the success of the weekend.
5. If the person cannot attend, it is the sponsor's duty to inform the Pre-Weekend Chair as soon as possible so that the opening can be filled by someone else.
6. The sponsor should see that the applicant has transportation to the send-off and home after the closing.
7. The sponsor should also attend the Service for the Dedication of the Crosses held immediately after the sendoff.
8. If the applicant is married, efforts should be made to ensure that the spouse's and family's needs are taken care of during the weekend.
9. The sponsor is responsible for obtaining palanca letters from a spouse (if applicable) and/or other family members and close friends. Please see that all letters get to the weekend Palanca Chair in sufficient time.
10. After the weekend, the sponsor should ensure that the applicant is introduced to a Reunion Group.
11. The sponsor should bring the applicant to an Ultreya, a send-off, and a Clausura as soon as possible. The applicant should attend a 4th Day Continuing Ed class after his/her weekend.

The special care and assistance given to your applicant will play a major part in assuring the success of his/her Fourth Day adventure.

Sponsorship Letter
